

# **LEAD SAFE RENOVATION**

Dust stirred up by renovation projects can expose people to lead (Pb) and other metals. It is important to protect children, pregnant women, workers and others from exposure to renovation dust.



- → All Do-It-Yourself home renovators in the Lower Columbia Region
- → Homeowners or tenants hiring a contractor
- → Renovation contractors working on homes

# FOLLOW THIS CHECKLIST TO REDUCE DUST

### **PREPARATION**

- Visit **thep.ca** to sign up for lead safe renovation supplies and soil testing if moving or disposing soil
- Watch our "Made in Trail" Lead Safe Renovation videos
- Remove and/or cover items in the work area
- Seal off the work area
- HEPA vacuum before you start

# **ON THE JOB**

- Keep family members and pets out of the work area
- Keep dust down as you go
- Tidy the work area each day
- Wear personal protective gear
- Wash hands & face before breaks
- Outdoors, don't do dusty jobs on windy days

## **WRAP UP**

- Remove all waste & dispose of safely
- HEPA shop vacuum entire work area
- Wash all surfaces from top down (even those you didn't work on)
- Repeat steps until you can't see any dust on a wet wipe
- Wash work clothes separately from other laundry
